

Bishop Rodney G. Brown is the anointed, visionary leader of Faith Dimension Church in Maylene, Alabama. Bishop Brown is the founding Pastor of Faith Dimension Church, Inc., A.D. 95.. God has blessed him with an amazing combination of diverse life experiences, which prepared him for his divine appointment at Faith Dimension Church.

Bishop Brown is joyously married to Lady Connie Brown and has two children, Austin and Indya Brown. His God-directed developmental path prepared him to handle the spiritual side of the church as well as the administrative and business sides.

Educationally, Bishop Brown earned a bachelor's degree in Business Administration from Samford/Faulkner University (Birmingham, AL). He earned a Master of Education from the University of Alabama at Birmingham with a concentration in Exceptional Education. In addition, Bishop Brown attended the University of Montevallo to obtain his Leadership Certificate in Administration which makes him eligible to become a school administrator.

Bishop Brown earned a Master in Divinity (Counseling) from Master's International School of Divinity-Seminary & Bible College(Evansville, IN.) Bishop Brown has also been awarded an honorary doctorate from CICA-International University & Seminary, Orlando, Florida. In addition, Bishop Brown continues to work toward his doctorate in leadership from Friends International Christian University in Merced, CA.

Under the leadership of the late Bishop Jasper Roby, Bishop Brown received his elder's ordination/license in the AOH Church of God in 1991. Bishop Brown was consecrated a Bishop in the Lord's Church during the first AIA Conference 2015, Apostle Joseph Hamilton, Chief Celebrant. Bishop Brown is an educator in the Hoover City Schools in Hoover, Alabama. Bishop Brown has taught in the public school system for 23 years.

Bishop Brown's voice articulates a Christ-centered, Bible-based message with relevance for the twenty-first century with clarity, precision, and conciseness. He uses a variety of sources to support his viewpoints. He uses quotations from Greek philosophers, African folktales, and contemporary sporting events in various sentences. His gifted preaching tackles the difficulties and issues of today and offers biblical solutions in an upbeat, encouraging manner.

HARDAWAY

ev. Dr. Vant Hardaway is the second of four children born to the late Overseer Gatha and Stella Hardaway. He spent most of his early childhood in the city of his birth, Birmingham, AL. A pastoral appointment for his father prompted a move of the Hardaway family to Athens, TN in 1956.

On the path of academic development, Dr. Hardaway received his B.A. degree from Tennessee Wesleyan College in 1971. His additional degrees include an M.A. in Educational Administration and Supervision from the University of Tennessee in Knoxville in 1987; an M.S. degree in Industrial and Organizational Psychology from the University of Tennessee in Chattanooga in 1989; an Education Specialist degree from Tennessee Technological University in 2008; and a Doctorate of Ministry from the Ministry International Institute in 2012. An honorary degree of Doctor of Public Service was conferred on May 1, 2021 by Tennessee Wesleyan University President and Board of Trustees.

Rev. Dr. Hardaway retired from his secular occupation as Supervisor of Safety and Equity with the McMinn County School System. Prior assignments in the education arena included Alternative School Supervisor, middle school History Teacher, and basketball coach. On the local and state level, he was a member of the Executive Committee of the Athens Education Association and served on the Tennessee Education Association Board of Directors.

His call to ministry was acknowledged in 1974. In the fall of 1977, he launched a "new start" ministry in Nashville, TN, which began as a Bible Study on the campus of Fisk University. In 1986, prompted by a desire to be support in the ministry of his aging parents, Dr. Hardaway relocated his family to his hometown of Athens, TN. In 1996, he accepted an opportunity to be a change agent in the restart of a ministry in Sweetwater, TN. Many were introduced to the gospel of Christ and baptism in the name of Jesus. In this ministry was the initiation of a two year bible college curriculum on

site. Participants earned an Associate degree in Ministry.

He received unction from the Lord in 2015 to extend his ministry into the wider kingdom. As a member of the AIA Fellowship since 2015, Bishop Hardaway currently serves as First Assistant and Membership Director. Bishop Hardaway is active in the Athens community by his association with the Tennessee Wesleyan University Board of Trustees, Starr Regional Hospital Board of Directors and volunteer chaplain, and Mentoring Supervisor for Court Appointed Special Advocate (CASA) Corridor of East Tennessee. He was named the 2016 Athens & McMinn County Man of the Year.

Bishop Vant Hardaway and his wife, Janice, reside in Athens, TN; parents of two daughters: Vanessa of Fayetteville, NC; and, Julie (Brandon) Williams of Athens. As grandparents, they enjoy the company of three grandchildren: Destiny, Jaekobi and Sydney.

THE PROMISE

"In the name of God Almighty I am called to be an Apostle of the Lord Jesus Christ and by Divine providence do solemnly declare that I shall faithfully and accountably serve in the Lord's church and shall dutifully observe and keep His statutes, ordinances and customs, and preserve the liberties of the churches and people entrusted to me; and shall set forward and promote such works as may be fitly done therein for the service of God, for the benefit of his Church, and for the extension of the Kingdom of God, so help me God through Jesus Christ our Lord."

The Ascending Apostles will sign the above Promise in the sight of all present. The witnesses add their signatures. All then stand. The Chief Celebrant then says the following words and asks for the response of the people.

THE RESPONSE

You have been assured of their suitability and that we, the Church, believe that they are suited for this sacred responsibility. Because you have accepted lofty responsibility and approved by the people, to lead this Church in the power of the Holy Spirit, I now call upon you to lead us in the confessing of our faith.

The Ascending Apostles begins by saying:

I believe in one God.

(Congregation will say.....)

I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord: who conceived of the Holy Ghost, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, dead and buried. He descended into hell. The third day, He arose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and sits at the right hand of God the Father Almighty, from thence, He shall come to judge the quick and the dead. I believe in the Holy Ghost, one holy, universal and apostolic Church, the communion of the saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body and life everlasting. Amen. (The Apostle's Creed, 340 A.D.)

THE SACRED ACT OF APOSTOLIC AFFIRMATION

While the people remain standing, the other apostles and bishops assist and stand to the right and left of the Chief Celebrant. The people remain standing, the Chief Celebrant offers up this prayer or prays as the spirit leads him.

THE INVESTITURE

The newly affirmed Apostle is now vested according to the order of apostles and bishops. This segment of the service is both colorful and solemn.

(After vesting, a Bible is presented with these words.)

"Receive the Holy Scriptures. Feed the flock of Christ committed to your charge, guard and defend them in His truth, and be a faithful steward of His Holy Word and Sacraments."

THE PROCLAMATION

The newly affirmed Apostles will then greet the church.

THE BENEDICTION AND RECESSIONAL



The **CASSOCK** is the foundation garment of the Bishop and Apostle, over which all other garments are layered. It is a close-fitting garment, reaching to the feet, and may be worn by all ordained clergy as a symbol of a servant. The Apostle wears the cassock in accordance with the Lord's instruction "whoever will be chief among you, let him be your servant." (Matthew 20:27)

The **CINCTURE** is a wide belt, which is tied around the waist, even as the Apostle is exhorted to gird herself with truth. It also speaks to us of the humility which our Lord girded Himself with a towel as He washed His disciples' feet.

The **ROCHET** is a white garment with full sleeves, which are tied at the wrist by bands. It is a ceremonial garment that serves as a symbol of the priesthood. It is reminiscent of the linen ephod worn by the high priest in the book of Leviticus.

The **CHIMERE** is a sleeveless gown worn over the rochet and represents the mantle of a prophet. It is worn exclusively by the Apostles and Bishops because they are the chief proclaimers and defenders of the faith in the apostolic tradition. It is often worn by Overseers with special dispensation.


The **TIPPET** is a skillful wide cut black material worn over the chimere, and may be embellished with the personal coat of arms of the Apostle or Bishop, the Diocesan coat of arms or the seminary of matriculation. The Tippet is used instead of the stole that is normally used with the Chausable.

The **ZUCCHETTO** is the indoor covering. A small, semispherical headdress, skullcap worn by the clergy. It is ordinarily made of cloth or skin. The color is scarlet, red-purple, blue-purple, cardinal-red or magenta.

The **GOLD CHAIN** & **PECTORAL CROSS** is worn only by Apostles and Bishops. The cross of Gold is hung around the Apostle's neck as a symbol of his imprisonment for Christ. The gold chain is a symbol of endurance, which emphasizes that the wearer is not a novice. The cross is the sign of salvation and man's redemption. Although it is placed on a beautiful gold chain, it is not suspended around the neck, but is placed in the left-hand pocket. Therefore it is not worn, but borne over the wearer's heart.

The **APOSTLE'S RING** is gold with amethyst or ruby depending on preference. It is worn on the right hand as the signet of the Bishop's authority, as well as his dedication to Christ and His Church.

The **CROZIER** is a tall staff which represents the office of the Shepherd. It is a symbol of a Bishop's authority and role as a watchman and overseer of God's precious people.

THE APOSTLE

(A brief synopsis)

An apostle is, in a sentence, a special messenger. More precisely, an apostle is a specially commissioned messenger. The first apostle was a "sent one". The very first "Sent One" was sent from heaven to earth to redeem humanity back to God. I Corinthians 15 calls him the Lord from heaven and the Spiritual Man. The principle was set in motion, a spiritual man must be apostle to go with power and spirit to snatch the chosen elect out of the hands of satan and the bowels of sin.

The Apostle's call's include the dispatch to a vision as God calls them to spearhead and dominate His new moves. The apostles of the age must exert supernatural power and exercise heavenly authority to once more call out those who have melded with the world church and forsaken the true and living God and his only Savior Jesus Christ. The word itself, we know well by now, means fundamentally a sent one. It describes one sent with extraordinary power on a mission, a delegation, on behalf of another, for a commissarial assignment.

It is a ministry of ambassadorship; meaning the sent one is dispatched to a foreign field to handle the affairs, settle the accounts, and negotiate agreements (which almost always includes peace terms and commerce pacts) in the best interests of the one who sent him.

An apostle is a delegate of the kingdom of God. Obviously, the foreign field he is sent to by the Lord is the kingdom of men. As a delegate, the apostle is deputized with certain powers and privileges that allow him to act largely independent of his Commissioner's direct involvement.

A "commission", is most basically, a written paper giving certain powers, privileges and duties to its bearer or the one named therein. It contains a warrant to confirm and verify the "sent one." The warrant outlines the reason the person is sent. the purpose for their mission, and the legal limits of their rights, privileges and proxy actions. The Commission Letter from the sending one attests to the sent one's authenticity. Its warrant serves the special function of backing the authority of the one who is sent, or the delegate. The Commissioner's Warrant defines the delegate's license to act and certifies the veracity of his service. A commission is the direct result of an appointment or election to perform certain accomplishments much like that of an agency. The orders, in summary, authorize, empower, and activate the delegate's service; and says to the citizens of the foreign land, or field and its government, the sent one is not alone and is acting with the full backing of the power that commissioned him.

The Apostle is the forerunner and the catalyst. The apostle is sent to aggressively take back what was stolen. To support his mandate of aggression, he is given enormous powers and phenomenal supernatural support. The apostle's presence in a land or a territory makes a difference. The Apostolic Ministry is never docile; it is never quiet, never easy on the nerves or soothing to the norm. The Apostolic Ministry is catalytic and, count on it, when this move takes place in the earth, once again the world will be turned upside down.

The Apostolate, as defined in several sources, is a standing office of a religious institution. It, the office has full divine accreditation with a universal commission. The position gives its officer full authority to initiate and act on behalf of his institution. He is its subsidiary. The apostolate is designed to revolve around oddly interactive and uniquely participatory exchange between the lord and the apostle. The office is more than a position or prescribed job description, it is a charge.
