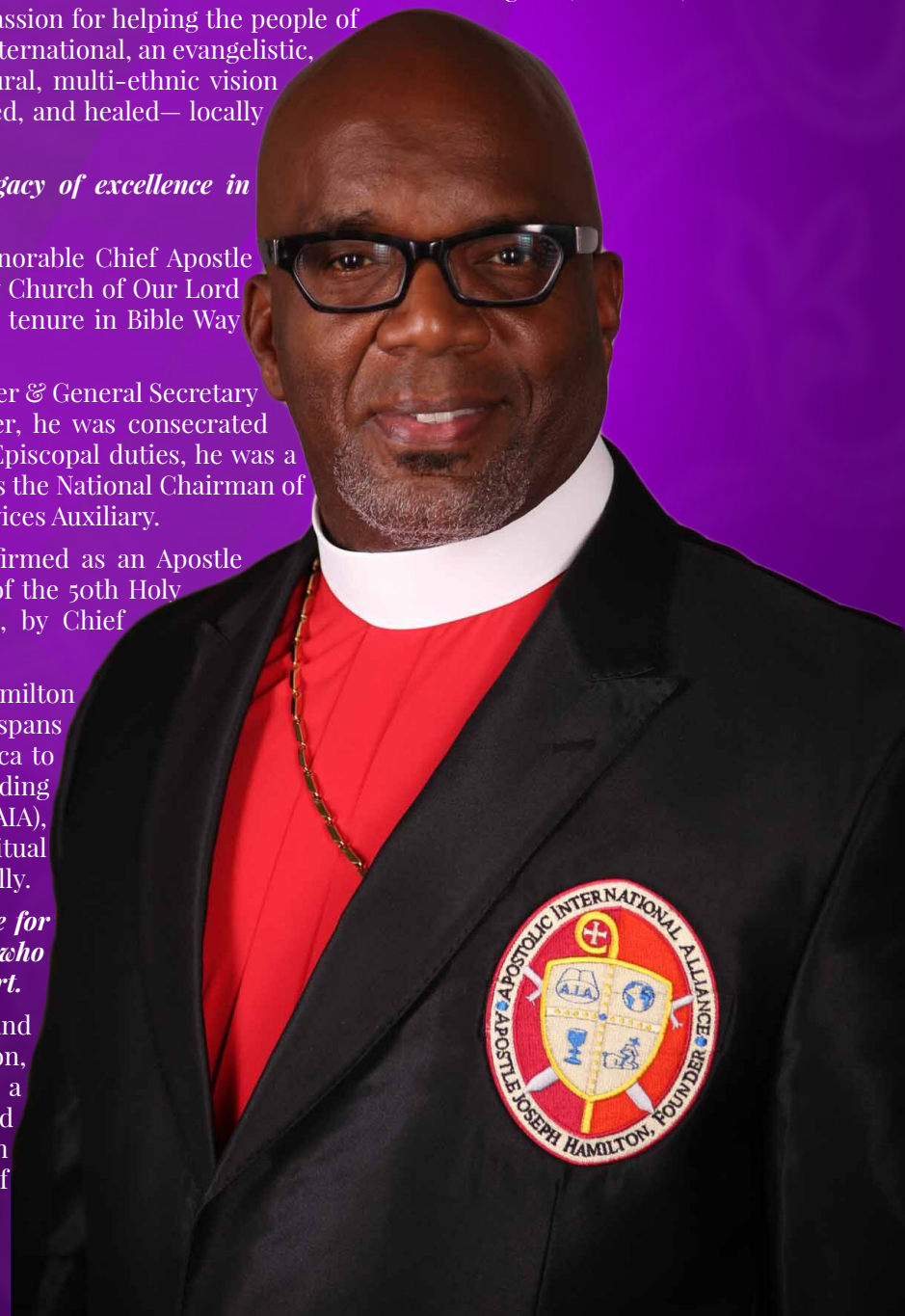

THE SACRED APPOINTMENT

THE CONSECRATION CHARGE

The Leadership and Governing Board of the Apostolic International Alliance, Inc. has expressed its confidence in you, in your character, in your devotion to Christ and Church, and in your ability to direct and promote the general affairs and interests of the entire Church, in that you are being honored with an appointment to the office of Overseer of Jamaica, West Indies.

The Apostle Paul says to “Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to feed the church of God, which he hath purchased with his own blood.” Likewise, Peter in his first epistle instructed, “The elders which are among you I exhort, who am also an elder, and a witness of the sufferings of Christ, and also a partaker of the glory that shall be revealed: feed the flock of God which is among you, taking the oversight thereof, not by constraint, but willingly; not for filthy lucre, but of a ready mind; neither as being lords over God’s heritage, but being ensamples to the flock. And when the chief Shepherd shall appear, ye shall receive a crown of glory that fadeth not away.

The Leadership and Governing Board of the Apostolic International Alliance, Inc. has assigned to you as Overseer the following duties:

- To be counseled and developed in this office by the AIA, Inc. Director of Credentials for an established time period, fully giving yourself to his godly counsel and admonition.
- To function as the administrative head of the West Indies region to which you are assigned. To set in order things lacking, and appoint suitable pastors.
- To work alongside these pastors in planning well-balanced congregational programs.
- To inspire the pastors and ministers to spiritual growth and personal improvement for more effective witnessing for Christ and his kingdom, to encourage pastoral visitations in homes, hospitals, and penal institutions.
- To stimulate by your life and example, as well as by your effective preaching, the outlook and vision of your people and inspire them to holier living and more dedicated, devotion the total Church program.

Inasmuch as the Holy Scriptures enjoin that no man be placed hastily in supervision of the affairs of the Church, and in order that those here may know your mind and purpose concerning this sacred office, will you in the fear of God answer the questions we ask you in the name of Christ and His Church.

ANSWER: “I WILL.”

Will you endeavor to live soberly, righteously, and godly as an overseer in the Church so that you may be an example to all others in Christian living?

ANSWER: “I WILL, BY THE HELP OF GOD.”

Will you instruct out of the Word of God to the edification of the whole church those who come under your care?

ANSWER: “I WILL DO SO, THE LORD BEING MY HELPER.”

Will you give diligence to faithfully perform all the duties assigned to you as an Overseer of West Indies region, according to the order and direction of the AIA Leadership and West Indies authorities?

ANSWER: “I WILL, BY THE HELP OF GOD.”

Will you ever seek in true humility, to deal justly and kindly with your brethren in the ministry and with all others over whom you are placed as an Overseer of the Church?

ANSWER: “I WILL DO SO, BY THE HELP AND GRACE OF GOD, THE HOLY SPIRIT BEING MY STRENGTH.
